Minutes for September 22, 2021 6:30 ET

The Special Called Meeting of the Irvington City Council was called to order by Mayor Yvonne Kennedy.

Prayer was by Council Member Bruce Basham, followed by the Pledge to the American Flag.

Council Members Bruce Basham, Pat Logsdon, Charles Douglas Lucas, Ronnie Robinson, Robert Young III were present. Council Member Ricky Lucas and City Attorney Rachel Brown were absent.

Charles Douglas Lucas moved to accept the minutes of the September 15, 2021 Special Called Meeting. Motion was seconded by Pat Logsdon. Motion passed by unanimous consent.

After Mayor Kennedy read Ordinance 2021-12 An Ordinance Levying the City of Irvington Ad Valorem Taxes, Council Member Bruce Basham moved to accept the second reading. Motion was seconded by Pat Logsdon. Roll call vote was taken with Pat Logsdon, Robert Young III, Ronnie Robinson, Charles Douglas Lucas and Bruce Basham voting "aye". Council Member Ricky Lucas was absent. Motion carried.

Mayor Kennedy read Ordinance2021-13 An Ordinance Adopting the Code of Ordinances for the City of Irvington. Council Member Bruce Basham moved to accept the first reading of Ordinance 2021-13. Motion was seconded by Ronnie Robinson. Roll call vote was taken with Ronnie Robinson, Bruce Basham, Charles Douglas Lucas, Robert Young III and Pat Logsdon voting "aye". Council Member Ricky Lucas was absent. Motion carried. Several of the council members asked for a copy of the new Code of Ordinances Book.

Robert Young III moved to advertise for bids on the sanitation. Motion was seconded by Ronnie Robinson. Motion carried by unanimous consent. Ronnie Robinson suggested we put the ad in Dodge Reports as well as many surrounding county newspapers. He also requested a copy of the bid package.

Mona Drane reported funds totaling \$45,000 are available for the parks from the LGEA fund and the current budgeted allotment. She is pursuing the disk golf for both parks. BBQ Pits at Eva Carmen Park need to be checked and repaired if necessary. One of the local Boy Scouts will be repairing the pavilion for his Eagle Scout project. Charles Douglas Lucas requested to use the Eva Carmen Park for a Trunk or Treat Event. Mona Drane informed the council 40 picnic tables were picked up from the Rough River State Park to be used at the Irvington city parks.

Bruce Basham moved to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by Charles Douglas Lucas. All voted affirmative. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
