**Regular Called Meeting**

**Minutes for November 7, 2022 7:00 ET**

The Regular Meeting of the Irvington City Council was called to order by Mayor Yvonne Kennedy at 7:00 pm ET.

Prayer was by Pastor Tim Lucas with the Irvington Baptist Church, followed by the Pledge to the American Flag.

Council Members Ricky Lucas, Ronnie Robinson, Robert Young III, Steve Haynes, Charles Douglas Lucas and City Attorney Rachel Brown were present. Council Member Pat Logsdon was absent.

Riley Sumner with Bluegrass Engineering presented the only water meter bid from Ferguson. Council Member Ricky Lucas moved to accept the bid. Motion was seconded by Ronnie Robinson. Motion carried by majority vote. The available funds will purchase approximately 630 meters. A change order was presented and signed by Mayor Kennedy excluding water line repairs. The \$150,000 Sewer Lift Station Project is waiting on LTADD to release so we can bid it out. The mayor received an email from the Hardinsburg City Clerk stating they would not supply water for any further projects at this time. There were two options discussed including tap on to Meade County Water or redirect the grant money for service line replacement. Council Member Ricky Lucas moved to redirect the \$443,000 to service line replacement. Motion was seconded by Council Member Steve Haynes. Motion carried by majority vote. The paperwork will be submitted to KIA for approval.

Council Member Charles Douglas Lucas moved to approve the minutes of the October 3, 2022 Regular Meeting. Motion was seconded by Council Member Robert Young III. Motion carried by majority vote.

Council Member Steve Haynes moved to approve the minutes of the October 24, 2022 Special Called meeting. Motion was seconded by Council Member Charles Douglas Lucas. Motion carried by majority vote.

City Clerk/Treasurer Mona Drane presented the treasurer's report. There were no questions.

City Clerk/Treasurer reported a total Meade Co RECC Collections for October - \$48,034.98. There were 21 City Stickers sold and no new business license applications. Overtime for October - 77 hours 15 minutes.

In the clerk's report, the 2022 Property Tax Bills were mailed on October 25. Work is ongoing for the FY2021 Audit. The City Christmas Tree will be located in the Women's Club Park this year. A small Christmas Park will be set up beside the Fire Department. City Clerk/Treasurer Mona Drane gave an overview of tasks and accomplishments during her tenure at City Hall. She will be retiring at the end of January, 2023.

Supervisor Chris Lucas reported the maintenance department had picked up garbage on the right of way, pumped tanks for five sewer problems, started working on the Christmas décor, worked on some graves at Cedar Hill Cemetery, had two water leaks and mowed some grass.

Mayor Kennedy stated the reviews she had read were not good on the gates for the cemetery entrance, so she is still looking into them.

Police Chief Brandon Brinkley reported 133 calls for service for October. 52 Total Citations, 74 Total Charges, 12 Outstanding Warrants, 20 Total Arrests, 1 Collision, 1 Domestic/JC3 and 16 Courtesy Notices. He also presented some of his career totals with total arrests at 1,115. Police Chief Brinkley announced this would be his last council meeting as he will be joining the Louisville Metro Police Department near the end of November. He thanked everyone for the opportunity to be Irvington Police Chief and encouraged the future mayors and councils to move in a positive direction for the city.

Fire Chief Brian Board was absent. No report was presented.

Mayor Kennedy announced U.S. Congressman Brett Guthrie will be the guest speaker at the Veteran's Memorial Ceremony on Friday, November 11, 2022 at Veteran's Memorial Park. Everyone is invited to attend.

There was no report for Vance Simmons Park.

A Trunk or Treat was held on October 29, 2022 at Eva Carman Park. After the event, some vandalism occurred and was reported to the police.

The Code Enforcement Board minutes of October 19, 2022 were submitted. There were no questions or comments.


Visitor Comments – No one signed in to speak.

A City Recognition/Retirement and Christmas Dinner will be held on December 10, 2022 at 5 PM ET. An invitation was extended to council, employees and families.

Council Member Ricky Lucas moved to adjourn. Council Member Steve Haynes seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous consent and the meeting was adjourned at 7:06 pm ET.
