**Regular Called Meeting**

**Minutes for October 3, 2022 7:00 ET**

The Regular Meeting of the Irvington City Council was called to order by Mayor Yvonne Kennedy at 7:00 pm ET.

Prayer was by Robert Young III, followed by the Pledge to the American Flag.

Council Members Robert Young III, Ricky Lucas, Charles Douglas Lucas and Steve Haynes were present. Council Members Ronnie Robinson, Pat Logsdon and City Attorney Rachel Brown were absent.

Council Member Charles Douglas Lucas moved to approve the minutes of the September 6, 2022 Regular Meeting. Motion was seconded by Council Member Steve Haynes. Motion carried by majority vote.

Council Member Charles Douglas Lucas moved to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2022 Public Hearing and Special Called meeting. Motion was seconded by Steve Haynes. Motion carried by majority vote.

Assistant City Clerk Kristie Taul presented the treasurer's report. There were no questions.

Assistant City Clerk Kristie Taul reported a total Meade Co RECC Collections for September - \$41,410.24. There were no City Stickers sold and 1 new business license application. Council Member Charles Douglas Lucas moved to approve the business license for Honest Abe Roofing. Motion was seconded by Council Member Steve Haynes. Motion carried by majority vote. Overtime for August - 121 hours 33 minutes.

In the clerk's report, Assistant City Clerk Kristie Taul reported she attended the KLC conference in Owensboro September 21-23, 2022 and is continuing to work on her masters. The Zoning Map Contract with Lincoln Trail ADD was signed 9-23-2022. Property tax bills are being prepared and will be mailed mid to late October. Christmas Parade will be November 19, 2022. Invitations are ready to be mailed. The 2020 audit is near completion. Mr. Lee has scheduled the 2021 audit for November and the 2022 audit for December. He plans to be here October 24, 2022 for the FY 2020 Audit Report.

Supervisor Chris Lucas was absent but sent in his report as follows: The maintenance department had picked up garbage on the right of way, done some dirt work on water leak repair spots, had 1 sewer issue, worked on graves at Cedar Hill Cemetery, mowed grass and sprayed weeds and fogged for mosquitos. Council Member Ricky Lucas asked to check with Riley Sumner to see if the meters need to be bid out or just the installation of the meters.

Mayor Kennedy stated the reviews she had read were not good on the gates for the cemetery entrance, so she is still looking into them.

Police Chief Brandon Brinkley was absent and no report was presented.

Brian Board presented the fire department report as follows: 39 Total Calls, 24 EMS and 15 Fire related. The 2022 Ford F150 is now ready for service. One fire inspection has been done. The ISO Audit is October 18, 2022. Three grant applications have been submitted for a Rescue Tool, AED and Gas Monitor. The seasonal burn ban is in effect. All residents are being encouraged to take their fallen leaves to the city burn pile.

There was no report from Veteran's Memorial Park.

There was no report for Vance Simmons Park.

The Code Enforcement Board minutes of September 21, 2022 were submitted. There were no questions or comments.

Visitor Comments - No one signed in to speak.

In Old Business, RV and Tiny Homes Ordinance Consideration, checking with City Attorney Rachel Brown.



Seconded by Council Member Ricky Lucas. Council Members Robert Young III and Charles Douglas Lucas wanted to read for a second reading. Mayor Yvonne Kennedy called for a vote to table.

Council Members Steve Haynes and Ricky Lucas Voted yes to table. Council Members Charles Douglas and Robert Young III voted no to table. Mayor Yvonne Kennedy broke the tie and voted to table until City Attorney Rachel Brown could be present.


