**Special Called Meeting**

**Minutes for February 16, 2022 7:00 ET**

The Special Called Meeting of the Irvington City Council was called to order by Mayor Yvonne Kennedy.

Prayer was by Mayor Kennedy, followed by the Pledge to the American Flag.

Council Members Pat Logsdon, Charles Douglas Lucas, Ricky Lucas, Robert Young III and Steven Haynes were present. City Attorney Rachel Brown and Council Member Ronnie Robinson were absent.

Steven Pickarski from KLC introduced two resolutions to the council concerning financing.

Steven Haynes moved to accept Resolution 2022-01, A Resolution Approving A Lease For The Financing Of A Project; Providing For The Payment And Security Of The Lease; And Authorizing The Execution Of Various Documents Related To Such Lease. Motion was seconded by Charles Douglas Lucas. A roll call vote was taken with all five council members present voting "aye". Motion carried.

Charles Douglas Lucas moved to accept Resolution 2022-02, A Resolution Of The City Of Irvington, Kentucky Approving An Interlocal Cooperation Agreement Among The City Of Irvington, Kentucky And Other Parties Thereto Regarding The Kentucky Bond Development Corporation And Authorizing Such Corporation To Issue Approximately \$9,800,000 Of Bonds In One Or More Series, Payable Solely From Revenues To Be Derived From A Loan Agreement With The Roman Catholic Diocese Of Lexington, Acting By And Through The Most Reverend John Stowe, Bishop To Refinance The Outstanding City Of Georgetown, Kentucky Industrial Building Revenue Bonds, Series 2016 (Saints Peter & Paul Regional Catholic School Project), The Proceeds Of Which Were Loaned To The Roman Catholic Diocese Of Lexington To Finance The Acquisition, Construction, Installation, And Equipping Of Additions And Improvements To The Campuses Of Saints Peter & Paul Regional Catholic School Located At 423 West Short Street, Lexington, Kentucky And 133 Barr Street, Lexington, Kentucky. Motion was seconded by Steven Haynes. A roll call vote was taken with all five council members present voting "aye". Motion carried.

Ricky Lucas asked City Clerk Mona Drane to look into senior discounts for garbage service. Ricky Lucas moved to accept the second reading of Ordinance 2022-02, An Ordinance Increasing Sanitation Rates for the City of Irvington. Motion was seconded by Charles Douglas Lucas. A roll call vote was taken with all five council members present voting "aye". Motion carried.

Charles Douglas Lucas moved to accept the second reading of Ordinance 2021-6.2, An Ordinance Adopting the City of Irvington Second Amended Annual Budget. Steven Haynes seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken with all five council members present voting "aye". Motion carried.

Charles Douglas Lucas moved to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by Steven Haynes. All voted affirmative. Motion carried and the meeting was adjourned.
