The January 26, 2022 Code Enforcement Board Meeting was called to order by Chairman Troy Simpson. Board Members Troy Simpson, William Ditto, Charlie Reesor and Rick Williams were present along with Mayor Yvonne Kennedy.

In old business, Mayor Kennedy has been in contact with the Highway Department and they are working on the “Speed Zone Ahead” sign to be placed on E. Hwy 60 before the “Jake Brake Ordinance Sign”.

Mayor Kennedy will prepare ordinance violation letters for 204 S. First Street and property at the corner of Caroline and N. Second Street. If no results in 30 days, legal action will be taken along with legal action on 117 N. First Street.

207 E. Walnut has a burn pile that needs to be burned.

300 S. Meadow Street – property owner has been advised to have vehicles removed.

Mayor will contact property owner of 103 W. Maple.

207 Pearl Street – action is being held due to pending court case.

110 Pearl Street – has burned pile of trash but still had other work that needs to be done.

Code Enforcement Board Member Jennifer Dowell resigned as of December 21, 2021. A letter was sent to a board member that has moved out of the city limits and no longer qualified to be on the board.

Troy Simpson moved to adjourn. Motion seconded by William Ditto. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
