**Special Called Meeting**  
**Minutes for June 12, 2023 7:00 ET**

The Special Called Meeting was called to order by Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas at 7:00 pm ET.

Prayer was by Robert Young, III, followed by the Pledge to the American Flag.

Council Members Billy Snyder, Jane Hettich, Robert Young III, Charles Poole, and Rhea Ballman were all present. Council Member Donald Board and City Attorney Rachel Brown were unable to attend.

Council Member Rhea Ballman moved to approve the minutes of the June 6, 2023 Special Called Meeting. Motion was seconded by Council Member Billy Snyder seconded the motion. Motion carried by majority vote with all Members present voting yes.

There were no visitor comments.

Old Business:

After a brief discussion of the FY 2023-2024 annual original budget, Mayor Lucas read second reading of Ordinance 2023-03, an Ordinance adopting the City of Irvington annual original budget for fiscal year of July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024 by estimating resources and appropriating funds for the operation of City government. Council Member Billy Snyder made a motion to approve the Ordinance on the budget as presented. Charles Poole seconded the motion. The Ordinance was approved with all Council Members present voting yes.

After a brief discussion, Mayor Lucas read second reading of Ordinance 2023-04, an Ordinance creating the position of Administrative Assistant. Council Member Jane Hettich made a motion to approve the Ordinance as read. Council Member Rhea Ballman seconded the motion. The Ordinance was approved with all Council Members present voting yes.

The only other item on the agenda was to approve funding for the lawnmower purchase that was approved at the June 6, 2023 Special Called Meeting in the amount of \$14,239.00. City Clerk Stephen Clark suggested that since the mower will be used to maintain the cemetery and there are sufficient cemetery funds available, consideration should be given to pay for the mower utilizing cemetery funds. After discussion of the needs and use of the mower, Council Member Rhea Ballman made a motion to use funds from the cemetery account to pay for the mower in the amount of \$14,239.00. Council Member Jane Hettich seconded the motion. Motion carried by majority vote with all Members voting yes.

New Business:

There was no new business.

As there was no further business, Council Member Rhea Ballman moved to adjourn. Council Member Billy Snyder seconded the motion. Motion carried by unanimous consent and the meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:15 pm ET.
