**MINUTES**  
**June 25, 2024**

**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas called the Special Called meeting to order at 7:00 pm ET. Prayer was led by Robert Young III followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag. The following Council Members were present: Robert Young III, Billy Snyder, Charles Poole, Karen Kinnison and Donald Board. Member absent: Rhea Ballman. Others present included: City Attorney Rachel Brown, City Clerk Sherrie Lawson and Ints Kampars with WXBC.

**OLD BUSINESS:**

- A. Ordinance 2024-05: Second Reading FY2024-2025 Budget  
Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas read Ordinance 2024-05, FY2024-2025 Budget to the Council. The general fund total was \$820,575.00 and the Water and Sewer fund total was \$1,415,735.00 with a total budget of \$2,236,310. Once completed Mayor Lucas opened the floor to discussion. After some discussion, Councilman Billy Snyder moved to approve and adopt Ordinance 2024-05 as read and Councilwoman Karen Kinnison seconded. Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas took a roll call vote and all members present voted aye. Motion carried unanimously. (See Ordinance for details).
- B. Ordinance 2024-01: Second Reading Increase Sanitation Rates  
Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas read Ordinance 2024-01 an ordinance pertaining to the increase of the current sanitation rates. Once read Mayor Lucas opened the floor to discussion. After some discussion, Councilman Billy Snyder moved to approve and adopt Ordinance 2024-01 as read and Councilman Charles Poole seconded. All members voting aye except Councilman Donald Board who voted nay. Motion carried. (3-1). (See Ordinance for details).
- C. Ordinance 2024-02: Second Reading Increase Water Rates  
Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas read Ordinance 2024-02 an ordinance pertaining to the increase of the current water rates. Once read Mayor Lucas opened the floor to discussion. Mayor Lucas explained that the increases were due to the increase on water received from the City of Hardinsburg (HMU) this year. Councilwoman Karen Kinnison express concerns about the four percent increase each year. City Clerk Sherrie Lawson explained that the Council can review the ordinances each year and make changes if necessary. After some discussion, Councilman Robert Young III moved to approve and adopt Ordinance 2024-02 as read and Councilman Billy Snyder seconded. All members voting aye except Councilman Donald Board who voted nay. Motion carried. (3-1). (See Ordinance for details).

**D. Ordinance 2024-03: Second Reading Increase Wastewater Rates**

Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas read Ordinance 2024-03 an ordinance pertaining to the increase of the current wastewater rates. Once read Mayor Lucas opened the floor to discussion. After some discussion, Councilman Billy Snyder moved to approve and adopt Ordinance 2024-03 as read and Councilman Robert Young III seconded. All members voting aye except Councilman Donald Board who voted nay. Motion carried. (3-1). (See Ordinance for details).

**E. Ordinance 2024-04: Second Reading Increase Tap-on Fee**

Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas read Ordinance 2024-04 an ordinance pertaining to the increase of the current Tap-on Fee rates. Once read Mayor Lucas opened the floor to discussion. After some discussion, Councilman Robert Young III moved to approve and adopt Ordinance 2024-04 as read and Councilman Billy Snyder seconded. All members voting aye. Motion carried unanimously.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**A. Appointment: Code Enforcement Board Members**

Mayor Charles Douglas Lucas appointed Troy Simpson, William Ditto, Rick Williams, Karran Carpenter and Harold Parente to the Code Enforcement Board with the swearing in to be July 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. Councilman Robert Young stated that the Code Enforcement Board meeting is schedule for Wednesday, July 17<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm at City Hall and is opened to the public.

**ADJOURN**

Councilman Robert Young III moved to adjourn this meeting with no further business to come before it and Councilman Charles Poole seconded. Motion carried by unanimous consent and meeting was adjourned at approximately 7:27 pm.
